Participation points or P-Pts Explained

- Defined: vocabulary words gained on a daily basis in which all students are responsible for. Identified at the beginning and defined throughout class.
- If tardy or absent you are responsible for the words, but don't receive credit for them unless arranged prior to your absence.
- Each day is worth 2 points—no matter how many words are presented.

Expectations to be met to earn p-pts daily

- 1. Have folder with p-pt sheet in it and seated when bell rings
- 2. Not late and do not use pass the entire period
- 3. Write words down in folder at the beginning of class
- 4. Throughout class, listen for words and their definitions and take notes
- 5. End of class, exit cards are used for definitions of the previous day's words

Other important information

- Each p-pt word will be on unit quizzes and final exam
- For unit quizzes, must write out definition (no matching)
- Must have accurate definition and all blanks on p-pt sheet filled!!
